INDEPENDENT STUDY AND DIRECTED READING
Academic Guidelines

A. Project Options:

1. Reading Project – 1,000 to 1,200 pages per credit hour. Choose a topic or an area to fill in a deficiency in student's curriculum. Brief critiques of reading with a conference at end of the project.
OR
2. Writing Project – Write a research paper(s). Follow the recommended format for a formal paper. There should be a conference following the reading of the paper. (10 to 13 pages per credit hour.)
OR
3. Lab Research Project – This research is to be conducted in a formal lab situation (i.e. science, art, etc.). Credit will be granted on the assumption that 40-50 hours of work equals one credit hour. A formal project report must be written and an oral report made.
OR

A careful mix of the above options.

B. Guidelines

1. At least 6 hours of background in the discipline are required.
2. The independent study may be taken for one, two, three, or four hours.
3. A faculty member must sponsor the project, but the student should be responsible for doing the planning necessary for the project. This is not a tutorial.
4. Regular catalog courses may not be taken as independent studies.
5. All categories (including outline, bibliography, and evaluation criteria) must be completed.
6. Grading may be SU or 'A' – 'U', at the option of the professor and the student (please specify under evaluation). To be used for major or minor, it must be graded, 'A' – 'U'.
7. The project should culminate in an evaluative conference. It is recommended that an oral presentation be made to a panel of several faculty and students.
