

Credit for Professional Development

Professional Schools and Training

You may be able to earn college credit for the following types of professional development training:

- ♦ *Seminars and workshops*
- ♦ *Certificate training programs*
- ♦ Apprenticeships and formalized on-the-job training
- ♦ Licenses

To apply for credit, you must have official documentation of the following:

- ♦ *Completion of the training* (certificate, letter, etc.)
- ♦ Contact hours spent in training
- Course content (workbook, outline, table of contents, abstract, etc.)

In addition, you must

- answer the four Professional Schools and Training questions (listed in the PST handbook) in order to articulate your learning
- prepare a Petition for Academic Credit

When preparing professional development experiences to be evaluated for credit, use the following guidelines:

- Eliminate all experiences you judge to be nonprofessional or below college-level
- Eliminate any experiences not thoroughly documented (completion, hours,
- Eliminate any experiences which obviously overlap any previous college course work.
